1494 days between Jan 31, 2022 and NOW, March 4, 2026. Currently 668,713 hits $\frac{688713 \text{ hits}}{1494 \text{ days}} = 460 \text{ PER DAY}$ Assuming a single person hits all 6 gardens, that is $460 / 6 = 80 / \text{day}$

According to the 2021 Census, approximately 52.6% of the city's 182,500 total private dwellings were single-detached houses, totaling roughly 96,000 units. Most built since 2005 are smaller lots.
